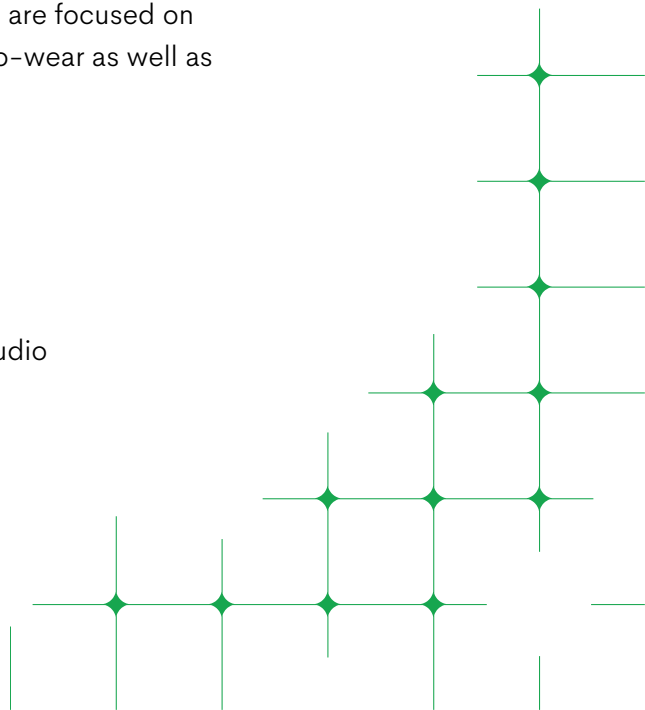
This recently-launched banner brand of the Philippine Fashion Industry highlights the handmade and slow fashion goods that are core to the DNA of the country's creators.

FILIPINO INNOVATION TEXTILES

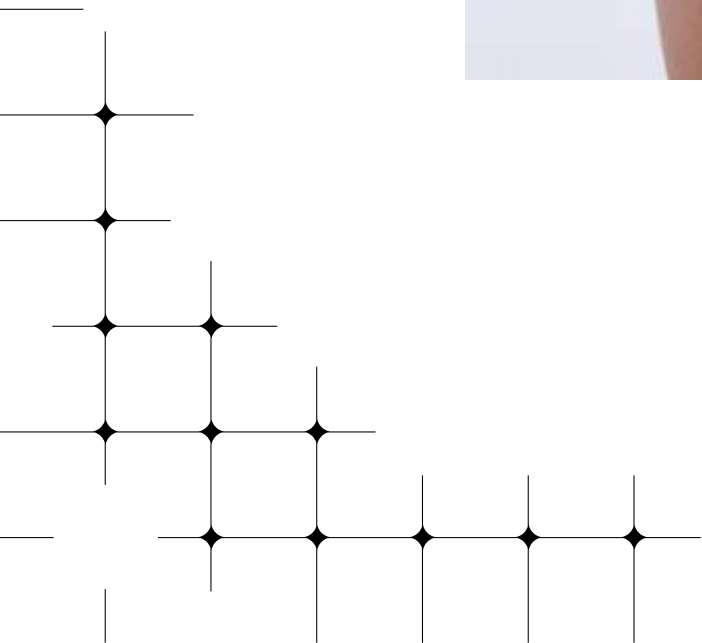
